OFFERS INTERNSHIP AND LEARNERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR UNEMPLOYED
GRADUATES**

The Department of Public Works, Roads and Transport in Mpumalanga is calling on unemployed graduates and learners with matric to apply for internship and learnership opportunities which exist within the Department.

The Department is offering a twelve month Internship opportunities to at least one hundred and twenty (120) unemployed graduate with diploma or degree within the various fields. The fields includes amongst others: Electrical, Civil engineering, Real estate, Public Management, Videography, Graphic design, Finance Accounting, Law, Human Resource Office Administration, Labour relations, ICT Management, Transport Management, Logistics and Security Management.

The Graduates will be deployed across the Departmental offices in the province which includes Bohlabela district, Ehlanzeni, Gert Sibande, Nkangala District and Head Office(City of Mbombela). Eligible candidates will enter into a one year contract with the Department and receive a monthly stipend depending on their qualifications.

On the other hand, youth between 18 and 35 years with matric will also have an opportunity to nurture their skills through Learnership programme offered by the Department. The Department is offering at least seventy (70) youth with matric an opportunity to enter into a twelve month learnership programme to receive training in artisanship skills such as bricklaying, electrical, plumbing and carpentry.

Interested graduates and matriculants can submit their applications on a Z83 forms obtained at any government department with CV, certified copies of qualifications and ID. The closing date for both the Internship and Learnership opportunities is 10 February 2017.
